COMMUNICATIONS ASSOCIATE - Part Time

The Communications Associate will assist in the development and execution of a communications plan and regular updates and messages representing the Responsible Offshore Science Alliance (ROSA).

In addition, the Communications Associate will be responsible for assisting in the planning and implementation of internal and external communications that support the mission, vision, goals, and achievements of ROSA.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Major Responsibilities and Duties

Communications and Graphic Arts:

- Lead and assist as needed with writing, editing, proofreading, and production of external communication materials, including press releases, feature stories or interviews, monthly e-newsletter (constant contact or similar platform), brochures, reports, video scripts, website content, letters, social media content, videos and special publications for distribution that align with ROSA and the organization's research projects.
- Develop collateral materials, flyers, presentation outlines, annual Year in Review and other materials as needed.
- Monitor and preserve graphic standards, style, and communication protocols.
- Assist with the coordination, promotion, and documentation of attendance at special events, conferences, and programs helping to publicize and promote organizational activities.

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- Use effective communication skills to present information accurately and clearly.
- Model high standards of professional integrity and maintain confidentiality of privileged information.

Social Media:

- Work with the ROSA executive director and staff to develop social media campaigns that help to achieve branding and communications goals.
- Manage the organization's social media accounts developing relevant content and engagement topics.
- Develop benchmark metrics to measure the results of efforts.
- Analyze and evaluate social media campaigns, key metrics, and strategies.

Website:

- Responsible for regular updates to and maintenance of the ROSA website (WordPress). Proficiency in WordPress is required.
- Write and edit web content.
- Monitor web traffic, performance, and capacity to identify, prevent and resolve issues.
- Maintain website content and functionality that meets the needs of the organization and users.
- Develop benchmark metrics to measure the results of efforts.
